

Proposed Site Location

The proposed 2 hectare site of the seagrass planting is within Dale Bay, within the Milford Haven Waterway and Pembrokeshire Marine SAC. This marine licence application requests a licence to plant this 2 hectare area somewhere within a 38.2 hectare seagrass search area (**see map below**). The exact location would be determined in conjunction with further stakeholder engagement to determine the most suitable area for local residents, and to ensure that it has no deleterious impact upon local livelihoods.

Following existing extensive local stakeholder engagement activities conducted by Pembrokeshire Coastal Forum, Swansea University propose this area in response to previous options proposed (contained within marine licence DEML 1925) being unacceptable to local community considerations.

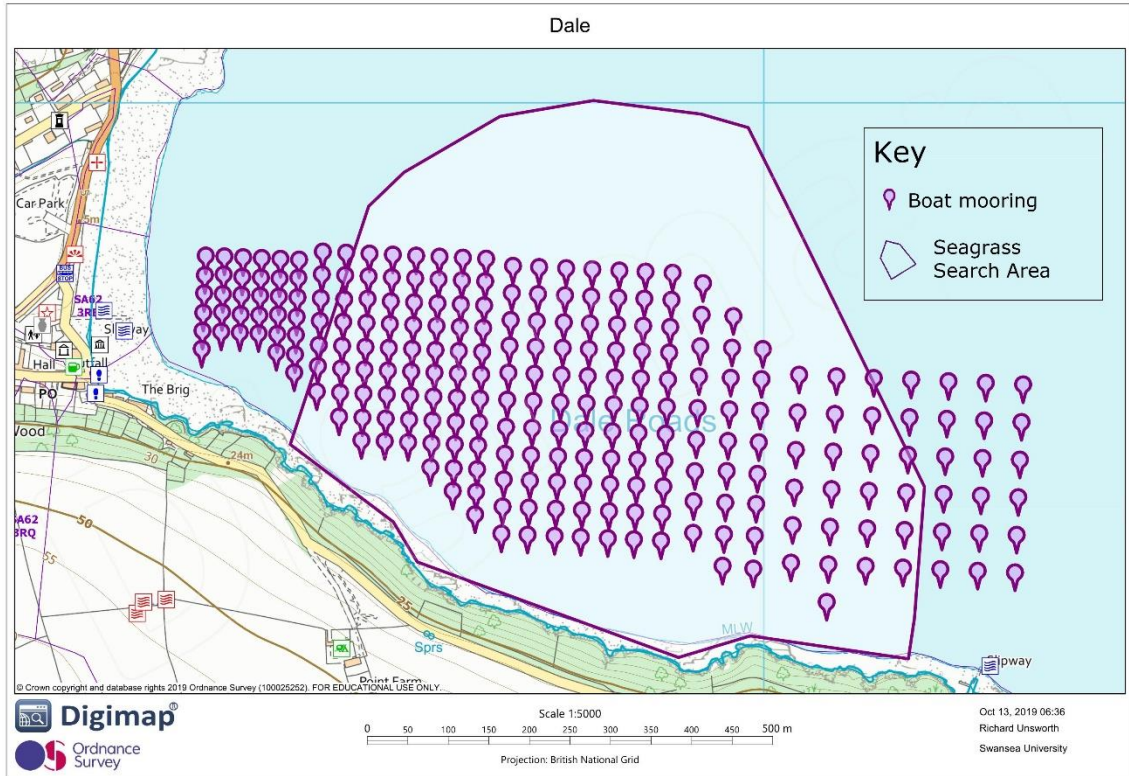


Figure 1. Map of proposed seagrass search area of interest within Dale Bay within which a **maximum of 2 hectares** of seagrass would be planted (based on stakeholder engagement). Map also shows the boat moorings that exist within the bay.
